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A Special Message from our National Chaplain – Jenny Quince

Kiaora everyone,

As you are all aware NZ is in the Red Zone.

What does that mean for us?

We can only have under 100 double vaccinated people gathered in one place - (we are currently running around 50 so that will not be a problem). There are no road or air blocks for travellers, therefore all attendees who

are double vaccinated, are able to attend, whether using air, vehicles or ferries.

Our booking at the conference venue, Cornerstone Church, is confirmed. We are booked from 7.30am to 9.00pm on both Friday and Saturday.

We have booked the whole complex although at this stage there is a "Car Boot Sale" happening outside Saturday morning. They have an enormous carpark, so I am sure we could ferry people from accommodation should carparking become a problem.

I have made the call that we will not go out to dinner on Saturday night. This is in a bid to continue to safeguard us all and means we will have both dinners at the Cornerstone Venue. They have a very modern / good kitchen / dishwasher / on a one storey layout. There are folding doors between the church and the meeting area, so while setting up for dinner, attendees can continue to meet in the church. There is also a private room for prayer.

Everyone needs to be seated for meals as well as morning and afternoon tea. There are two trolleys available for this scenario and we will need a couple of "Daisies" to help with serving please. For both Lunch and Dinner melas, there will be a menu from which you can choose – and your meal will be delivered to your table.

Cornerstone do not require us to do any "deep-cleaning" – but we will need to have a couple of "Daisies" fluffing around wiping chairs and benches. A vacuum cleaner is available if needed. The Cornerstone cleaners will come in at night, after we have left and sort out the cleanliness needs. If you would like to volunteer to be one of the "Daisies" please let me know.
